Ann - we don't get to see each other at any other time, maybe have a coffee, tea time, keep in touch

Jill - I like this proposal, it looks at inclusivity, break out room conversation, there needs to be clarification around what is the meeting, pre-meeting, after meeting, and what's app, conversation.

Jean - greeter before the meeting, 23 other hours in the day, we can reach out on the telephone, text to get to know each other.

Susan - everytime I've been in the pre-meeting I've been greeted, we may not get a volunteer, we have a hard time with volunteers as it is.

Karen K - over time - time to vote to extend time, but also let before meeting be before meeting. Kind of a social time. Always seen people greeted.

Kate - maybe because I admit people I notice that people don't get greeted Claudia - biggest problem I see, only a few people are dominating the conversation, we do try to say hi to people, how do we try to let people know that we need to stop and say hi to newcomers and stop our conversation?
